Prevent works at the pre-criminal stage and is an initiative design to 'prevent' individuals becoming extremists.

Signs of radicalisation

Fixated on subject Closed to new ideas Change in language or use of words Asking inappropriate questions Scripted speech	Short tempered Angry Arrogant Withdrawn Depressed Change in behavioural responses	Tattoos Use of internet Change in routine New circle of friends Absent Change in appearance-hair, clothing

Actions to be carried out in school

1. Notice the concern
2. Check with others; have they got similar concerns
3. Share the concern- DSL

A member of SLT will then refer the concern through an Early Help Form, this goes to Channel Panel who decide on any necessary further action.
